



Ghana Grid Company Limited (GRIDCo) proposes to construct, operate and maintain an approximately 18.5km double circuit high voltage 161kV transmission line facility to meet the industrial energy demand in the Bono and Ahafo Regions. The 161kV transmission line route is to T-off from the existing Sunyani – Kenyasi 161kV transmission line at Domeabra in the Sunyani Municipality in the Bono Region to a new substation near Afresepakrom in the Tano North District of Ahafo Region. The development is known as “**161kV Ahafo North Transmission Line Project**”.

The proposed undertaking would traverse close to the following communities within the Sunyani Municipality: Domeabra, Suyaw, Abesem, Fawonsuo, Kofikrom, Abesim-Nkrakrom, Nkrankese, Sai Village, Fahiakotwere and Tano North District: Tanoso, Susuanso, Afresepakrom, Tekyere, Yamfo, Yaw Danko in the Bono and Ahafo Regions respectively.
