



ADVERTISER'S ANNOUNCEMENT

The Ghana Grid Company Limited (GRIDCo) proposes to construct, operate, and maintain an approximately 18.5Km double circuit high voltage 161kV transmission line facility to meet the industrial energy demand in the Bono and Ahafo Regions. The 161kV transmission line route is to Tee-off from the existing Sunyani - Kenyasi 161 kV transmission line at the “Kwesimfum” a community in the Sunyani Municipality in the Bono Region to a new substation near the town of Afrisipakrom in the Tano North Municipality in the Ahafo Region. The development is known as the **“161 kV Ahafo North Transmission Line Project”**.

The proposed undertaking would traverse close to the following communities in the Sunyani Municipality: Kwesimfum, Suyaw, Abesim, Fawonsuo, Kofikrom, Kwesimfum, Suyaw, Abesim, Fawonsuo and Kofikrom and in the Tano North District: Afrisipakrom, Susuanso, Tanoso and Techire in the Bono and Ahafo Regions respectively.

In line with the EPA Act 490, 1994 and the LI 1652 of 1999, GRIDCo has submitted a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) of the proposed undertaking to the Environmental Protection Agency for review. Copies of the Draft EIS are available at the EPA offices in Accra and Sunyani as well as the GRIDCo's Head office in Tema.

Notice of the proposed transmission line project is hereby served for public information, as required under the procedures for the conduct of EIA in accordance with Regulation 15(1) of LI. 1652.
