INTERRUPTION IN POWER SUPPLY

(GRIDCo) and the Electricity Company of Ghana (ECG) wish to inform the public that due to a challenge at the Ghana National Gas Limited Company (GNGC) Gas Processing Plant (GPP) at Atuabo, gas supply for power generation has been limited which has caused some customers to experience intermittent interruption in power supply.

We apologise unreservedly for the inconveniences caused to the public as a result of this challenge.

Engineers from GNGC are currently working to address the issue and restore full supply of gas.

GRIDCo and ECG will continue to monitor the situation which is expected to normalise once the issue at the plant is addressed.

Ghana Grid Company LTD. (GRIDCo) was incorporated in December 2006 to carry out the economic dispatching and transmission of electricity from facilities of wholesale suppliers (Independent Power Producers [IPPs]) to bulk customers and distribution utilities in Ghana and West Africa. The Company became operational on August 1, 2008, following the transfer of the Transmission System Department and its core staff from VRA to GRIDCo. It operates the National Interconnected Transmission System (NITS). GRIDCo currently transmits electricity to thirty-one (32) Bulk Customers and Distribution Utilities from eleven (11) Wholesale Suppliers, including the Volta River Authority (VRA).
