FAULT AT AFIENYA SUBSTATION

Tema, 12th February 2026 — The Ghana Grid Company Ltd. (GRIDCo) wishes to inform the general public, especially customers served from the Afienya Substation, that at 00:01 hours on Thursday, 12th February 2026, a 161/34.5kV, 50/66MVA transformer at the Afienya Substation developed a fault.

Our engineers responded promptly and are currently conducting detailed assessments on the transformer to determine the cause of the fault and carry out the necessary repairs.

As a result of this outage, customers supplied from the Afienya Substation are currently without power. GRIDCo is working closely with the Electricity Company of Ghana (ECG) to restore supply as quickly and safely as possible.

We sincerely apologise for the inconvenience caused and assure the public that every effort is being made to resolve the situation promptly. We appreciate the patience and cooperation of all affected stakeholders.

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Note to Editors:

Ghana Grid Company Limited (GRIDCo) was incorporated in December 2006 to carry out the economic dispatching and transmission of electricity from facilities of wholesale suppliers (Independent Power Producers [IPPs]) to bulk customers and distribution utilities in Ghana and West Africa. The Company became operational on August 1, 2008, following the transfer of the Transmission System Department and its core staff from VRA to GRIDCo. It operates the National Interconnected Transmission System (NITS). GRIDCo currently transmits electricity to thirty-one (31) Bulk Customers and Distribution Utilities from eleven (11) Wholesale Suppliers, including the Volta River Authority (VRA).
