GRIDCo AFIENYA SUBSTATION - TRANSFORMER UPGRADE WORK

The Ghana Grid Company LTD. (GRIDCo) wishes to inform the general public particularly residents of Afienva and surrounding communities that GRIDCo is set to commence upgrade works on a power transformer at its Afienva Substation in the Greater Accra Region.

The upgrade work will commence on Tuesday 3rd February 2026 and will take five (5) weeks to complete. This involves the replacement of an existing 50/66 MVA power transformer with a new higher capacity (120/145 MVA) power transformer.

The transformer upgrade will significantly increase the substation's capacity. This will enable it to serve more customers and provide reliable power supply to residents, businesses and communities served from the Afienva substation.

Our engineers, in collaboration with the Electricity Company of Ghana (ECG) have put in place all necessary measures to ensure that the transformer upgrade work does not cause any disruption of supply to consumers.

GRIDCo and ECG wish to thank all consumers for their cooperation as these works continue.

Note to Editors:

Ghana Grid Company LTD. (GRIDCo) was incorporated in December 2006 to carry out the economic dispatching and transmission of electricity from facilities of wholesale suppliers (Independent Power Producers [IPPs]) to bulk customers and distribution utilities in Ghana and West Africa. The Company became operational on August 1, 2008, following the transfer of the Transmission System Department and its core staff from VRA to GRIDCo. It operates the National Interconnected Transmission System (NITS). GRIDCo currently transmits electricity to thirty-three (33) Bulk Customers and Distribution Utilities from eleven (11) Wholesale Suppliers, including the Volta River Authority (VRA).
